This is what Our Holy Father said to
the estimated 3 million young people
gathered on Copacabana beach for the
opening ceremony of World Youth Day
in Rio de Janeiro.

"Put on faith" and life will take on a
new flavour, life will have a compass to
show you the way; "put on hope" and
every one of your days will be enlight-
ened, your horizons will no longer be
dark, but luminous; "put on love" and
your life will be like a house built on a
rock, your journey will be joyful be-
cause you will find many friends to
journey with you."

He went on to say; "Jesus brings God to
us and us to God...Put on Christ in your
life and you will find a friend in whom
you can always trust; put on Christ and
you will see wings of hope spreading
and letting you journey with joy to-
wards the future; put on Christ and your
life will be full of His love and will be a
fruitful life...Put Christ in your life,
place your trust in Him and you will
never be disappointed! You will see
how faith accomplishes a revolution in
us. It puts God at the centre...With God
peace, consolation, gentleness, courage,
serenity & joy...find a home in our
heart then our very being is trans-
formed...Let yourselves be loved by
Christ, he is a friend that will not disap-
