#### **CONFIRMATION.**

It is that time of year again when our parish, together with every parish around the world, celebrates one of the high points of the year, and indeed a high point in the lives of many young people, namely the conferring of Confirmation. The celebration of this great Sacrament - one of the 3 Sacraments of Initiation and which indeed completes initiation into the catholic church, is not just a significant event in the lives of the young people and of their families. It also enriches us all as we all form part of the one body which we call the church.

On Friday last, May 2<sup>nd</sup> 55 young people were confirmed by Bishop Jim Moriarty and on Friday next, May 9<sup>th</sup> a further 88 young people will be confirmed by Monsignor Alex Stenson.

The young people have been preparing for this day for a long time and most of them have completed the Parish Preparation programme called '*You Shall Be My Witnesses*'.

As we reflect on this great occasion it might be a good time to recall our own confirmation, to recall the promises and commitment we made and pray for a renewal, or fresh outpouring of those 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Courage, Reverence, Knowledge, Right Judgement and Wonder & Awe in God's presence.

Take a moment and imagine a world populated by people living their lives in Love, Kindness, Faithfulness, Goodness, Joy, Peace, Gentleness, Patience & Self Control. These Fruits of the Holy Spirit are evidence that the tree is healthy. That our roots are being fertilised and nourished from a good source.

Please pray for the girls & boys that they may indeed be His witnesses.
