**CHURCH RENOVATION - ROOF REPAIR.**

The interior works for the Church renovation are now complete and there seems to be universal satisfaction with the works.

The total costs for the works amounted to €310,000 and thanks to the loyal commitment by parishioners towards the family offering the Parish will not go into any debt. During the renovation it was observed by the builders and architect that the roof needed, as a matter of urgency, remedial work to prevent leakage. This work will commence on the 26<sup>th</sup> May - weather permitting and it will last 2/3 weeks. The cost will be €26,000. The Church will not close during roof renovation. When completed no further works are planned for the Church in the immediate future.
